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
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SIM Program Overview

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) State Innovation Model (SIM) initiative is focused on testing the ability of state governments to use regulatory, policy, and payer levers to *accelerate health transformation*.

- Provides financial and technical support to states for developing and testing state-led, multi-payer health care payment and service delivery models that will impact all residents
- The overall goals of the SIM initiative:
 - *Establish public and private collaboration with multi-payer and multi-stakeholder engagement*
 - *Improve population health*
 - *Transform health care payment and delivery systems*
 - *Decrease total per capita health care spending*


