Program Overview

- Joint collaboration between Partners In Health Network (PIHN) and CoventryCares of WV, developed in 2006
- Improve quality outcomes for membership, while encouraging wellness activities
- CCWV has 52% of the current TANF population in the participating counties
- 60% of that membership receives care at a PIHN provider site in one of those counties



Areas of Focus

- Effectiveness of Care
 - WCC - Weight Assessment & Counseling for Nutrition & Physical Activity for Children/Adolescents
 - CIS - Childhood Immunization Status
 - LSC - Lead Screening in Children
 - IMA - Immunizations for Adolescents
 - CDC - Comprehensive Diabetes Care
- Access/Availability of Care
 - PPC - Prenatal & Postpartum Care
 - FPC - Frequency of Prenatal Care
- Use of services
 - W15 - Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life
 - W34 - Well-Child Visits in the Third, Fourth, Fifth & Sixth Years of Life
 - AWC - Adolescent Well-Care Visits

Outcomes of Collaboration

- Improved HEDIS scores with participating sites
- NCQA Certified PCMH locations
- Increased training on Medical Documentation
- Sponsored childhood and adolescent obesity programs in rural counties

What does it mean to collaborate?

- Real-time communication between both parties
 - Face to face meetings with individual sites
 - Quarterly group meetings
- Monthly and Quarterly Reports of non-compliant members
- Flexibility

New Initiatives

- Enter the top non compliant members in CAPGate, PIHN's web based registry in order to track care real time.
- Place diabetic retinal cameras in rural health centers connected to CAMC Ophthalmology Group for real time screening.
- Collaborate on MVP Project.
- Preventive Dental for Pregnant Moms
